

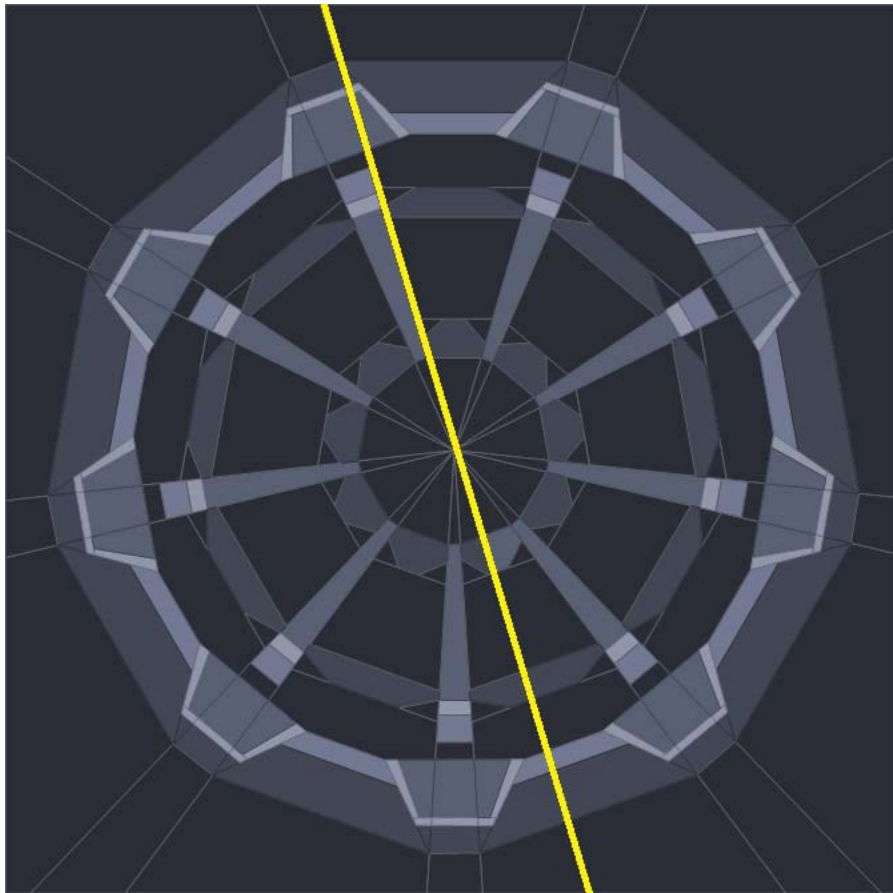
# Vault Door from Fallout

Version 1.0 (9/04/17)

This block should be a 12 inch block finished. There are  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowances. There are a total of 6 colors. The number on the vault door can be embroidered on or can be applied with permanent fabric paint/marker. Enjoy! In general, the block is constructed in two halves, then those two halves are sewn together along a straight diagonal. As you will see, since the block has a radial pattern, piecing will be similar for similar sections.



Construction is as follows:

Make (A+B+C+D). Make E. Join = Slice 1.

Make (F+G+H+I+J). Make K. Join = Slice 2.

Make (L+M+N+O+P). Make Q. Join = Slice 3.

Make (R+S+T+U+V). Make W. Join = Slice 4.

Make (X+Y+Z+AA+AB) = Slice 5.

Join Slices 1 through 5. Set aside.

Make (AD+AE+AF). Make AG. Join = Slice 6.

Make (AH+AI+AJ+AK+AL). Make AM. Join = Slice 7.

Make (AN+AO+AP+AQ+AR). Make AS. Join = Slide 8.

Make (AT+AU+AV+AW+AX). Make AY. Join = Slice 9.

Make (AZ+BA+BB+BC+BD). Make AC. Join = Slice 10.

Join Slices 6 through 10. Join two halves together.

Embroider as described.
